Directions:

From North or South on Rt 128 (I-95) take Route 3 North from Burlington, MA, or from I-495 North or South take Route 3 North from Chelmsford, MA. Take Exit 33 (Route 40) and at the bottom of the ramp turn right (under Rt 3) and head West toward Groton. Go about 3 miles and take a left at the United Gas Station on the Left. This is Nutting Rd. We are the 6th house on the right after the condos on the corner. We are number 74.

This is a beautiful drive and spring should be in full swing by then, so, I am looking forward to seeing all of you on the drive. I will have coffee and donuts for those arriving hungry before the drive. This event is rain or shine.
